GEORGE P. TIGER MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION PRINCIPAL CHIEF

I know the statements below are true.

- George Tiger, in 2009 signed a contract with Mr. Shane Rolls, a casino developer, to receive 5%
 of gaming revenue from a casino within Muscogee (Creek) Nation boundaries, and to be a part
 owner of this Kialegee Tribal Town casino in Broken Arrow, OK.
- The Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council voted unanimously 12-0 in March of 2015 requesting George Tiger's resignation as Principal Chief.
- George Tiger received a letter from the Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council asking for his resignation as Principal Chief due to the contract against the Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
- George Tiger took payments from Shane Rolls for consulting with Giles and Kialegee Tribal Town. (Giles and a sister are owners of the land needed by Kialegee for casino.) This is BRIBERY.
- George Tiger supported Kialegee Tribal Town to compete with Muscogee (Creek) Nation in a casino operation in Muscogee (Creek) Nation's boundaries. I believe this to be <u>TREASON</u>.
- George Tiger was involved in <u>EMBEZZLEMENT</u> of over \$33,000 from the Okmulgee Indian Community.
- 7. George Tiger has never held steady employment outside tribal areas.
- George Tiger, in my opinion, has committed TREASON for having a secret contract to include himself as part owner of a casino to be owned by a family within the Muscogee (Creek) Nation's boundaries, against his own tribe's best interests.
- George Tiger had a 'Breach of Contract' by Johnna Townsend filed on him 8/19/2013 which shows a lack of professional actions. This was due to a violation of the <u>VIOLENCE AGAINST</u> WOMEN ACT of 2013.
- 10. George Tiger accepted Christmas money, while a Muscogee (Creek) Nation National Council Representative, in the amount of \$299.99 (Ck. #5274) from the Bristow Indian Community. This is illegal for an elected official. If a check is written at \$300.00 or over, it must be approved by a vote of the community.
- 11. George Tiger interfered with the actions of a Manager on Duty when his stepdaughter and son-inlaw were having an altercation with patrons at RiverSpirit casino.
- 12. George Tiger refuses to prosecute known criminal activities within his authority which is common knowledge of many employees, of <u>SEXUAL HARRASSMENT</u> and <u>COMPUTER KIDDY PORN</u>.
- 13. George Tiger has shown propensity for nepotism in hiring, and in termination of other employees.
